ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)		[£1650]
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.		
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements		[£455]
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care		[£125]
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at [both] the funeral director's [branch premises] [and at other] [non-branch premises]		[£345]

UNATTENDED FUNERAL		
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.
